MORISFARMS "ROSAMUNDI" ROSATO 2024

Toscana DOC, Italy

Clean, crisp palate of red berries, lime zest, candied rose petals, and buttercream. The Moris family came to Tuscany, Italy from Spain in the 1800's, this wine is made from some of the oldest Sangiovese vines in the area.

LIOCO CARIGNAN ROSÉ "INDICA" 2024

Mendocino County, California

Rose water, white raspberry, peach pit, and white guava are trademarks for this Rosé from Mendocino. Made from the Carignan grape, this wine is a gastronomic treasure that will pair with all your summer food fair, it is made in very small batches. Organic.

CIBONNE "TENTATIONS" COTE DE PROVENCE, 2024

Provence, France

Clos Cibonne is a historic estate in Provence overlooking the Mediterranean Sea. The family is famous for revitalizing the ancient Tibouren grape - the foundation of all their wines. A refined & rich organic rosé unveils delicate notes of stone fruits, mild spices, and a hint of minerality.

AMEZTOI TXAKOLI ROSADO "RUBENTIS" 2024

The Basque Country, Spain

Crisp and dry with tangy cherry and orange zest notes, it's racy acidity and minerality define Txakoli, the slightly fizzy wines from Spanish Basque country.

The backbone of the blend comes from the Hondarrabi Beltza grape vineyard planted in 1840, preserved by the Ameztoi family for 7+ generations.

QUEST DIVISION WINE CO. 2024

Columbia Valley, Washington

Captures the essence of the Pacific Northwest in every bottle, with delicate red berries, crushed strawberries, and pomegranate, underscored by a whisper of wet stone minerality. It celebrates the Gamay Noir varietal, thriving in the Columbia Valley's distinctive terroir of rolling hills, volcanic soils, and arid warmth. Organic.

BODEGAS OLIVARES ORGANIC ROSADO, 2024

Jumilla, Spain

A phenomenal value, made from old vine, dry farmed Garnacha in Jumilla (SE Spain). Zesty notes of raspberry, cherry, citrus, and white flowers making it fresh, balanced, and lively. Organic and made in small batches.
